This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students achieve a 'C' standard or above in English, by the end of 2018.
- Ensure 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 achieve National Minimum Standards in Reading and Writing.

Our initiatives include

- Individualised case management of student achievement across grades P-6 for English.
- Implementation of reading intervention practices, with resources targeted at students who are operating below Regional Regression Analysis.
- Implement Gradual Release of Responsibility techniques Modelled, Shared, Guided, Independent.
- Implement Instructional Teaching Cycle.
- Monitor early phase literacy, including the scheduling of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress, and strategies for intervention.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide TRS and Professional Development to build the capacity of teachers and teacher aides in the teaching of English for the implementation of Quality Teaching and Learning strategies **\$ 5,806**
- Purchase resources to support focused and intensive teaching for identified students **\$ 2,468**
- Employ additional teacher aide hours to run Levelled Literacy Intervention and targeted small group reading and writing sessions for case managed students **\$18,822**
