- 80% of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, by the end of 2017
- 80% of students in Years 3 & 5 achieving National Minimum Standards in Reading and Writing

Our initiatives include

- Individualised Case management of student achievement across grades P-6 for English
- Implementation of reading intervention practices, with resources targeted at students who are operating below Regional Regression Analysis
- Implement Gradual Release of Responsibility techniques Modelled, Shared, Guided, Independent
- Implement Instructional Teaching Cycle
- Monitor early phase literacy, including the scheduling of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide TRS and Professional Development to build the capacity of teachers and teacher aides in the teaching of English for the implementation of Quality Teaching & Learning strategies \$2206
- Purchase resources to support the focused and intensive teaching for identified students \$11499
- Employ additional Teacher Aide hours to run Levelled Literacy Intervention for case managed students \$8,675
